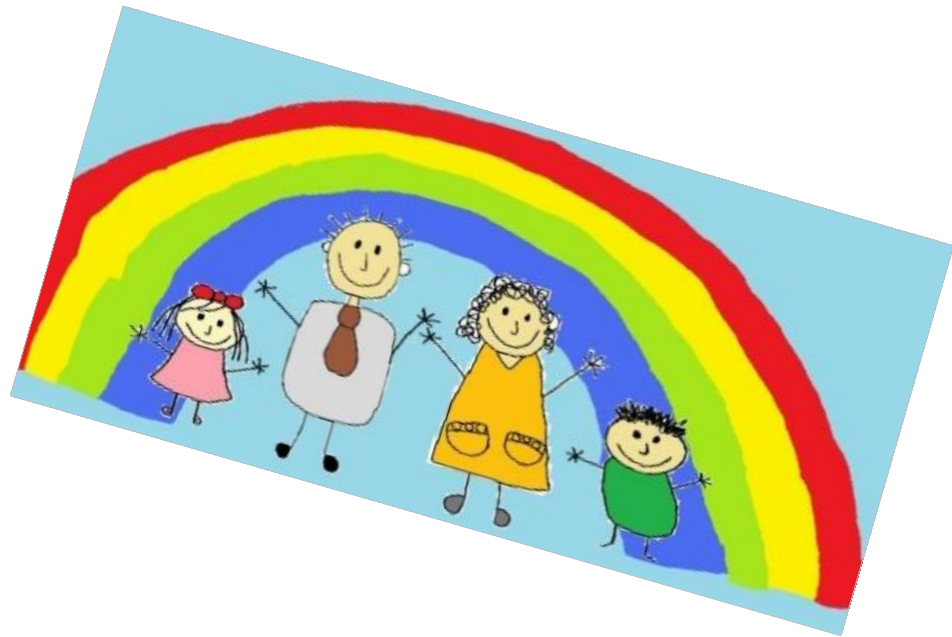

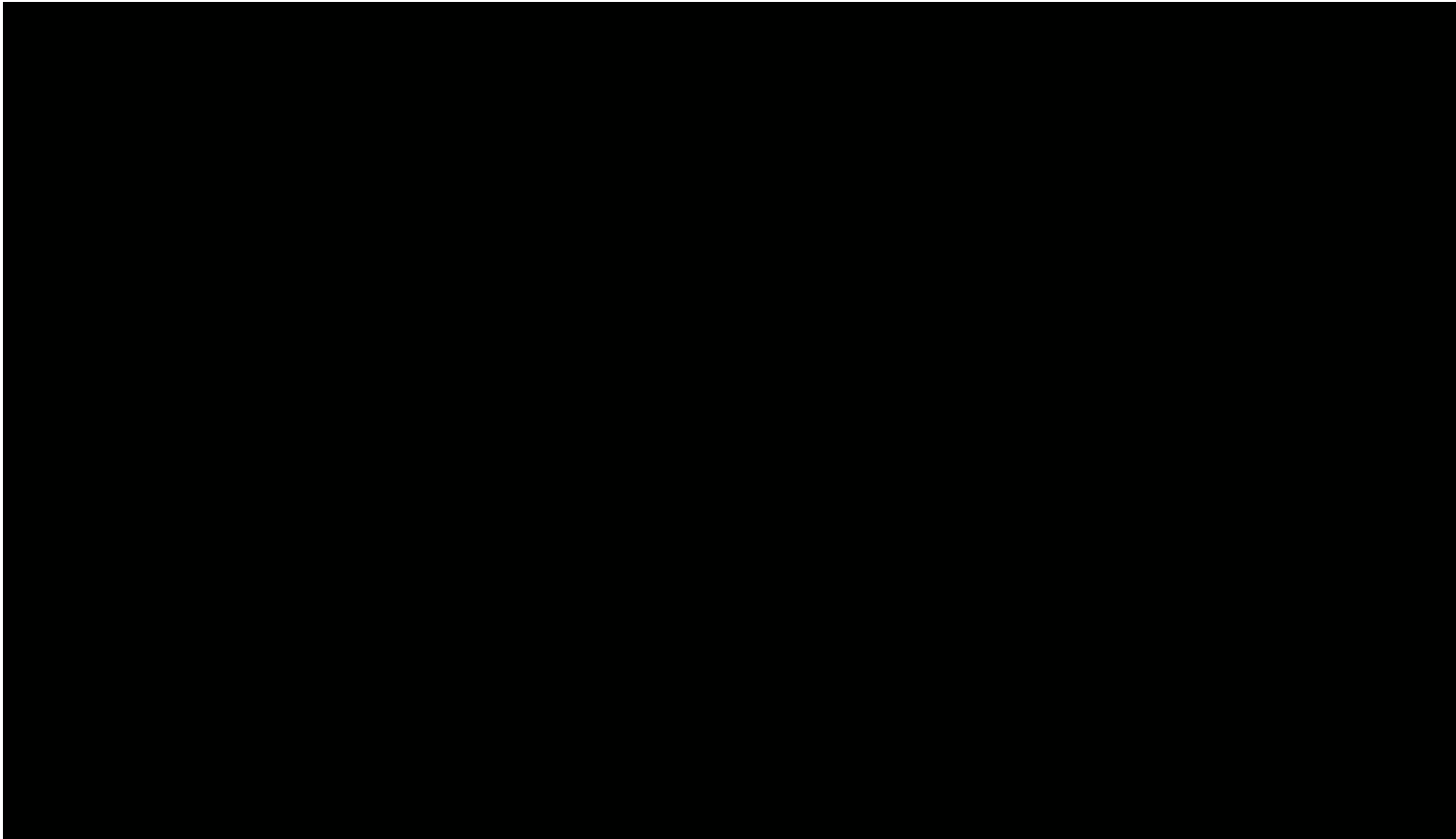


# Why we need this support
